A Maintenance Support volunteer is responsible for providing a broad spectrum of upkeep, repair and preventative maintenance functions as directed by the Maintenance Coordinator. Specific accountabilities include painting, appliance repair, minor facilities repair, carpentry and regularly scheduled Ronald McDonald House London maintenance. In addition to prioritizing both personal and guest safety at all times, Maintenance Support responsibilities include but are not limited to:

## 1. Property Oversight:

- i. Prioritize maintenance repairs as directed by Maintenance Coordinator;
- ii. Regular facility checks, identifying and communicating repairs required;
- iii. Maintain grounds during all seasonal needs including but not limited to snow removal, gardening, lawn mowing, leaf blowing/bagging;
- iv. Minor guest room repairs including but not limited to fixing bedframes, changing light bulbs, fixing window latches;
- v. Minor drywall and paint repairs throughout common spaces and guest rooms; and
- vi. Carpet cleaning throughout common spaces and guest rooms.

## 2. Systems Oversight:

- i. Changing batteries and updating security system locks;
- ii. Minor plumbing maintenance including but not limited to addressing clogged drains, plugged toilets, leaky faucets; and
- iii. HVAC filter changes.
